Through the sustainable tourism project: RIMARTES. Riches of the sea, treasures of the deep, we want to forge an encounter with the immense wealth of the Galician sea and our underwater heritage.

We have more than 300 kilometres of coastline and fifty wrecks to discover between the Gulf of Ártabro, the Costa da Morte (Coast of Death) and Estuary of Muros - Noia, under the sea and from land. ATLANTIC BASTION ROUTE

The coast of the Gulf of Ártabro stands out due to its strategic location on the European Atlantic arc with a capricious, sometimes treacherous orography, dotted with defensive bastions.
